Summary Statement

OSA's 67th Annual Meeting seeks to expand the practical knowledge base of the practicing anesthesiologist in a variety of areas. Areas of emphasis include: simulation topics; airway issues; lung injuries; airway workshop; preoperative evaluation issues; thoracic surgery issues; pediatric evaluation and assessment; malpractice issues and pulmonary hypertension issues; Malpractice issues, pulmonary hypertension issues and ultrasound guided regional anesthesia issues. Experts will present and discuss these topics with an emphasis on practical clinical approaches that will work for a primary anesthesia provider, resident supervisor or other anesthesia practitioner.
