Areas of emphasis include: simulation topics; airway issues; airway workshop; bleeding & clotting issues; obstetric anesthesia issues; substance abuse issues; nerve blocks; and prescription tracking issues. Experts will present and discuss these topics with an emphasis on practical clinical approaches that will work for a primary anesthesia provider, resident supervisor or other anesthesia practitioner.

Walking Tour of Downtown Cincinnati.
